# Make It Stick

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## IN THE CAR

Ask your kid, "Why should we seek God's wisdom?"



## HANGING OUT

Ask your kid why it's important not to just "wing it" but to get good advice and gain knowledge before taking action. Give some examples of mistakes that you've made and how you could have avoided those mistakes.



## AT DINNER

- What is the value of Proverbs?
- Why are we foolish to hate wisdom and instruction?
- What kinds of consequences could we avoid if we listened to God's Word?



## AT BEDTIME

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse: "Wisdom is worth more than rubies. Nothing you want can compare with her." Proverbs 8:11 (NIRV)



## PARENT TIME

The Book of Proverbs is God's practical guide for everyday life — short, memorable wisdom that gives kids real tools for real situations like handling conflict, choosing friends wisely, and knowing when to speak and when to stay quiet. Because most proverbs are just one or two sentences long, they're easy for children to memorize and carry with them long after the conversation ends. The best way to share it is simply to read one verse together at breakfast or bedtime, ask "where could you use this today?" and let God's Word do the rest.
