The Woman at the Well

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: John 4:1-42

Jesus Knows Us Completely and Loves Us Completely



IN THE CAR:

Ask:

- “What do you think ‘living water’ feels like?” Let kids imagine: Is it sparkly? Does it make your heart feel full?
- “If Jesus sat next to you at lunch, what would He say He knows about you?” Affirm that Jesus knows and loves them completely.
- “Who do you think the woman told first?” Talk about how we can share Jesus with friends too.



HANGING OUT:

Casual Faith Chats:

- “What’s something you know about your best friend?” Then ask: “Jesus knows even more—and still loves us!”
- “If you had to draw ‘living water,’ what would it look like?” Turn this into a doodle or chalk art moment.
- “What’s one way we can be like the woman and share Jesus this week?” Brainstorm simple ideas: kindness, inviting someone, praying for a friend.



AT DINNER:

Ask:

- “What’s something you’ve done that you’re glad Jesus forgives?” Parents can model vulnerability here.
- “Why do you think Jesus talked to someone others ignored?” Discuss kindness, inclusion, and seeing people like Jesus does.
- “What would you put in your ‘bucket of blessings’?” Let each person name things Jesus gives: peace, joy, hope, etc.



AT BEDTIME:

Pray: “Jesus,
Thank You for knowing us and loving us.
Fill our hearts with Your living water and help us share Your love with others.
Amen.”



PARENT TIME:

Connect the dots this week with **encouragement**. When you see your child obey, show kindness, or choose truth, say: **“That’s what listening to Jesus looks like. I’m proud of you.”**
